ROBOTICS IS A PRIORITY AREA OF TECHNOLOGICAL BREAKTHROUGH

The era of the fourth industrial revolution is a period of profound and rapid changes in the technological, economic and social spheres. Therefore, today's educational programs should be focused on the development of the ability to constantly adapt to change and acquire new knowledge. For this purpose, one of the new educational programs introduced by Al-Farabi Kazakh National University in the educational process is "Robotics Systems".

Robotics is one of the innovative digital technologies in the field of "Digitalization of industries" in accordance with the state program "Digital Kazakhstan" adopted in the country.

The specialty "Robotic Systems" is an interdisciplinary specialty in the field of mechanics, information systems and electronics. The educational program has an applied orientation and is aimed at the practical application of research in this area.

During the development of this program, which is taught at the Department of Mechanics, Faculty of Mechanics and Mathematics, the best practices of foreign partners - Lawrence, Bridgeport (USA), Science and Technology (Poland), Berlin (Germany), Sorbonne (France) and others were studied. requests and opinions of employers. The curriculum also includes subjects in accordance with the international project APPLE, which is implemented under the European program ERASMUS + European Union.

The training and research laboratory "Mechatronics and Robotics" of the department is equipped with modern devices, in particular, KazBot android robots, industrial robot UR- 10, milling and laser machines, 3D-printer.

Under the guidance of scientists, students of the program for the first time in Kazakhstan developed a humanoid robot "Farabi" and a social robot "Ai-Gerim" on the basis of the android robot InMoov. Ai-Gerim robot was awarded a diploma of the 3rd International Silk Road Robotics Innovation Competition. In addition, the team "TechnoRIM", consisting of students majoring in "Robotic Systems", this year took part in the II Republican University Championship ETU Robocon and won the third place.





AMBASSADORIAL HOUR

Al-Farabi KazNU was paid an official visit by Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United Mexican States, Mr. Jose Lui Martinez Arnandez. At a meeting with the leadership of the university, the prospects for cooperation between the parties in the field of science, culture and education were discussed.

Al-Farabi KazNU and the National Autonomous University of Mexico signed an agreement on the implementation of joint projects. Within the framework of cooperation, Professor Hernando Cuivedo participated in scientific research of the Department of Theoretical and Nuclear Physics and trained five doctoral students of the university. Currently, the university is interested in strengthening ties with universities in Mexico in three areas: nuclear physics, history, medicine and joint publication of books.

In turn, thanking for the warm welcome, the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United Mexican States, Mr. Jose Louis Martinez Arnandez, expressed readiness to actively promote the development of bilateral relations. He spoke about the activities of the representative office of the National Autonomous University in Madrid, which focuses on the internationalization of education, interacts with the academic community around the world. After briefly familiarizing the meeting participants with the main areas of activity (education, research and cultural development), he elaborated on the university's own television projects aimed at popularizing the work of the legendary director Luis Bunuel, the founder of surrealism in cinema.

In conclusion, the parties came to an agreement on establishing cooperation with the representative office of the National Autonomous University in Madrid, and it was also decided to consider the draft publication – a short course in the history of Mexico in the Publishing House "Kazakh University". The parties exchanged souvenirs. The Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United Mexican States, Mr. Jose Luis Martinez Hernandez, presented the university with valuable publications, including a brief history of the country.





LEADERSHIP LECTURE

Al-Farabi Kazakh National University is expanding cooperation with foreign colleagues, achieving high results and new opportunities. Bilateral cooperation agreements have been signed with 550 universities and research centers in 50 countries around the world.

More than 100 teachers have improved their qualifications in the world's top 300 universities.

Well-known scientists invited at the initiative of the rector – mathematician Ualbai Omirbai, who works at Wayne University of Detroit (USA), and neuroscientist Bazylbek Davletov from Cambridge - today have become the favorite teachers of Al-Farabi KazNU students.

Also, more than 40 professors gave lectures abroad, in higher educational institutions of Hungary, Germany, Mongolia, France, the USA, Russia, Turkey, Uzbekistan and other countries.

Teachers and staff of the country's leading university are now focused on training for advanced training at the Universities of George Washington, Humboldt, Imperial College London, higher education institutions of Wisconsin, Pennsylvania, Berlin, Tokyo.





KAZAKHSTAN 30 YEARS IN THE UN

Al-Farabi KazNU hosted a seminar dedicated to the 30th anniversary of Kazakhstan's accession to the United Nations.

The event was organized on the eve of a significant day by the Ban Ki-moon Institute for Sustainable Development with the support of the UN Information Center in Kazakhstan. The Faculty of Oriental Studies and the UNESCO Chair for Sustainable Development of the Faculty of Geography and Environmental Management of the University also acted as co-organizers.

Representative of the UN Department of Global Communications in the Republic of Kazakhstan Vlastimil Samek spoke to the students. During an interesting and productive conversation, issues on the history and main activities of this international organization, as well as the long-term cooperation of Al-Farabi KazNU with UN structures under the sign of commitment to peace and sustainable development were covered. Since 2014, the country's leading university has been the Global Hub of the United Nations Academic Impact program on sustainable development. From this point of view, the event is of particular relevance. In the anniversary year, the Ban Ki-moon Institute for Sustainable Development plans to hold a series of meetings for the academic community on various areas of UN activities.

Throughout its independence, Kazakhstan has been fruitfully interacting with the UN system and demonstrating its full commitment to the goals and principles of the Charter of the Organization. As President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev noted: "30 years ago, Kazakhstan became a full member of the UN. We fruitfully cooperate with the Organization in matters of global security and building a harmonious society. In the face of growing geopolitical tensions, we are in favor of strengthening the UN and its consolidating role."

Recall that on March 2, 1992, following the results of the 46th session of the General Assembly of the United Nations, by resolution 46/224, the Republic of Kazakhstan was unanimously admitted to membership in the UN.

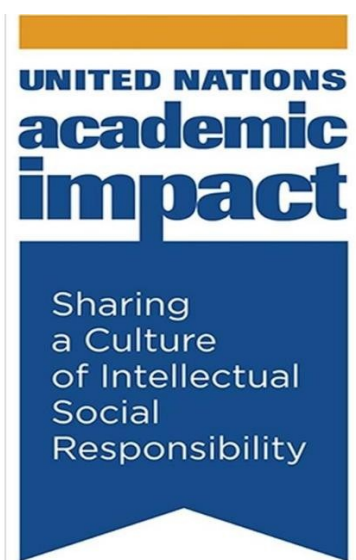
Al-Farabi KazNU will continue to lead the Global Hub of the United Nations "Academic Impact" Program (UNAI) for Sustainable Development. This was announced by the Head of the Department of Partnerships and Global Interactions of the "Academic Impact" program of the UN Robert Skinner. This is of particular importance in the year of the 30th anniversary of Kazakhstan's accession to the UN.

In his official address, R. Skinner noted: "Al-Farabi KazNU has represented itself strongly as a UNAI Hub, and we look forward to our continuing relationship. ... We are grateful for Al-Farabi KazNU's contribution to the advancement of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, as well as the fundamental and overall principle of promoting sustainability through higher education."

Al-Farabi KazNU headed the Global Hub in 2014. This undoubtedly contributes to strengthening the role of Kazakhstan as one of the key figures in the international process of solving global problems and promoting the idea of the Head of the State K. Tokayev to turn the city of Almaty into a Regional Hub of Multilateral Diplomacy and Sustainable Development.

In 2018, Al-Farabi KazNU together with the UN Alliance of Civilizations and the Representation of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the UN, hosted the international conference in New York at the UN Headquarters on the problems of Global Citizenship and presented the legacy of the Great Thinker Abu Nasr Al-Farabi to the world community. An important international event was in 2020 in cooperation with the UN Alliance of Civilizations – the conference "Mind for Peace", dedicated to the 1150th anniversary of the great Al-Farabi and the 75th anniversary of the UN with the participation of the UN Under- Secretary-General Fabrizio Hochschild and the High Representative of the UN Alliance of Civilizations Miguel Angel Moratinos.





UNIVERSITY OF TSUKUBA JOINS INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION FAIR 2021 ORGANIZED BY BOLASHAQ DEVELOPMENT FUND

On October 26th-29th, 2021, Asst. Prof. SASAYAMA Hiroshi, project coordinator, Study in Japan Global Network Project, Prof. NINOMIYA Takashi, University of Tsukuba Almaty Office coordinator based at Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, Mozgunova Aleksandra of the Moscow Liaison Desk, and Yahiro Tatiana of the Office of Global Initiatives, participated in the International Education Fair (IEF2021) organized by the Bolashaq Development Fund. Our faculty and staff members explained the processes and procedures of entry to a Japanese university or graduate school, and participating students inquired about English programs in the fields of architecture, international relations, energy such as oil and natural gas, and about application procedures for Japanese MEXT scholarships.





ONLINE STUDY IN JAPAN FAIR FOR KAZAKHSTAN AND KYRGYZ

The Japan Centers in Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan and the Study in Japan Global Network Project (Russia and CIS region) co-hosted a Study in Japan Fair from November 13th -19th, 2021.

A total of 18 Japanese universities and Japanese language schools participated in the fair. More than 1,300 students from Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan joined information sessions on studying in Japan. The University of Tsukuba was represented by Asst. Prof. SASAYAMA Hiroshi, staff members from the Office of Global Initiatives, NINOMIYA Takashi, Almaty Office coordinator and professor at Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, and Mozgunova Aleksandra of the Moscow Liaison Desk. They explained the undergraduate and graduate English programs in medical science, informatics, international relations, public health, etc. at the University of Tsukuba, as well as the required Japanese or English language level for admission, and how to obtain scholarships. About 80 participants visited the University of Tsukuba's booth.





INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION "MEDIA NAURUZ" STARTED

The international competition for press services and journalists of universities and scientific institutions of the Greater Altai and Central Asia "Media-Nauruz" started at the Altai State University (Russia, Barnaul). The jury included representatives of Al-Farabi KazNU.

The organizer of the competition was the Scientific and Educational Center for Altaic and Turkic Studies "Greater Altai" together with the Association of Asian Universities and the Guild of Interethnic Journalism.

"Media-Nauruz" is held within the framework of the project "The Turkic World of the Greater Altai: Unity and Diversity in History and Modernity" with the aim of popularizing the topics of Altaic and Turkic studies in the media space of the Greater Altai and Central Asia and strengthening international information cooperation between universities and scientific institutions of Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan and other countries of the Central Asian region.

The authoritative jury includes: General Director of the TV channel "Big Asia" Alexander Lebedev, Professor of the Kyrgyz-Russian Slavic University named after B.N. Yeltsin Gulmira Dzhunushalieva, Dean of the Faculty of Journalism of the National University of Uzbekistan named after M. Ulugbek Makhlia Mirsoatova, Academician of the Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio, professor of political science at Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Layla Akhmetova and others.

The winner will receive a nominal prize of the head of the project "Turkic World of Greater Altai", President of the Altai State University, Professor Sergei Zemlyukov. The best journalists and press service employees will be awarded free participation in advanced training courses from Altai State University under the program "Ethnoculture and modern art practices of the regions of the Greater Altai", "Methods for peer review of communication products" or "Fundamentals of DataScience and data visualization in Python".

A BRANCH OF MEPHI WILL OPEN IN AL-FARABI KAZNU

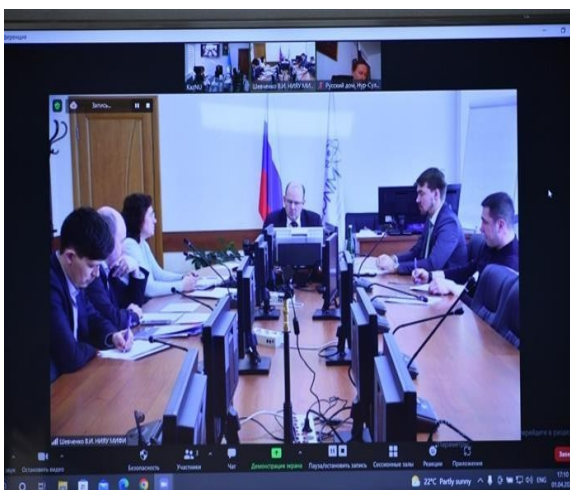
The Government of Kazakhstan and Russia signed an agreement on the establishment and functioning of branches of organizations of higher and postgraduate education of the two countries. A Roadmap has been approved by the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the implementation of the agreement.

In this regard, Chairman of the Board-Rector of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Zhanseit Tuimebayev held a meeting with the leadership of the National Research Nuclear University "MEPhI" in an online format.

The parties discussed issues on further cooperation, in particular on the opening of a branch of MEPhI on the basis of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University.

The head of the university, Zhanseit Tuimebayev, informed the Rector of MEPhI Vladimir Shevchenko about the work carried out at the moment in this direction.

"To date, a draft Roadmap and an agreement between Al-Farabi KazNU and MEPhI have been developed, grants have been allocated for training at a branch of the Moscow Institute on the basis of our university as part of a state educational order for personnel training. Also, the Ministry of Education and Science has previously determined admission to the branch without UNT in accordance with the rules of admission to MEPhI. In addition, a list of directions and educational programs were determined and the issues of locating a branch on the basis of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University were considered," Zhanseit Tuimebayev said.



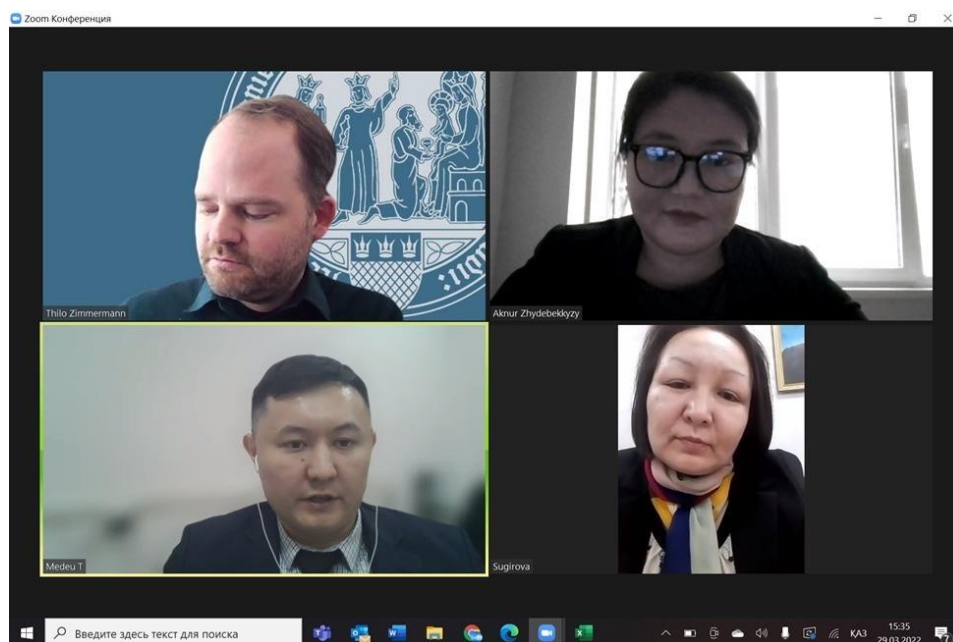


MEETING WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF COLOGNE DR. THILO ZIMMERMANN

AL-FARABI KAZNU HAS IMPROVED ITS PERFORMANCE IN THE WORLD RANKINGS

Today, the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University named after is the only Kazakh university that is included in the top 200 best universities in the world. Al-Farabi KazNU is dynamically advancing in the subject ranking of QS by Subject, achieving high indicators in it for the second year.

If in 2021 the group of the best directions of preparation included 11, in 2022 their number increased to 16. Thus, this year, Al-Farabi KazNU strengthened the indicators in QS by Subject 2022.

In particular, the specialty "Modern Linguistics" once again showed excellent results and rose to 60th place among the best universities in the world.

The specialty "Linguistics" entered the top 101-150, and "Religious Studies" and "Anthropology" for the first time appeared in the top 101-150.

"English Language and Literature" and "Jurisprudence" are in the top 151-200.

Also "Archaeology" and "Philosophy" specialties for the first time entered the prestigious international ranking this year, were marked in the group 151-200, and EP "Politics and International Studies" entered the top-201-220 among the best in the world.

"Economics and Econometrics" and "Mathematics" were 251-300, while "Physics and Astronomy" were 451-500.

In addition, Al-Farabi KazNU has improved its overall score in the Arts and Humanities subject this year, rising from 156 to 145th place compared to 2021. Also retained its position in the 451-500 group of scientific disciplines and the "Engineering" specialty.

As a result, Al-Farabi KazNU once again proved its leadership in Central Asia and the former Soviet Union.





AL-FARABI KAZNU HAS EXPANDED COOPERATION WITH ACCELS

Dr. D. Davidson, one of the founders of the American Councils for International Education (ACCELS), visited Al-Farabi Kazakh National University.

Dr. Davidson is the permanent president of the American Councils for International Education. Until 2017 and is currently the Honorary President, Director of the Research Center and Senior Academic Advisor of the organization. He is also the co-founder and chairman of the Center for Education, Assessment and Teaching Methods (CEATM) in Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan), the first independent university admission testing program in the post-Soviet space.

During the visit, the American scientist and organizer of education met with the Chairman of the Board – Rector of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Zhanseit Tuimebayev.

The head of the University expressed readiness to further promote the partnership that promotes the development of higher education and science.

30 YEARS OF KAZAKH DIPLOMACY

The International scientific-practical conference "Thirty years of foreign policy and diplomacy of sovereign Kazakhstan: achievements, challenges, and prospects" started at Al-Farabi Kazakh National University.

ONLINE MEETING OF PARTNER COUNTRIES WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE EU ERASMUS+ PROGRAM

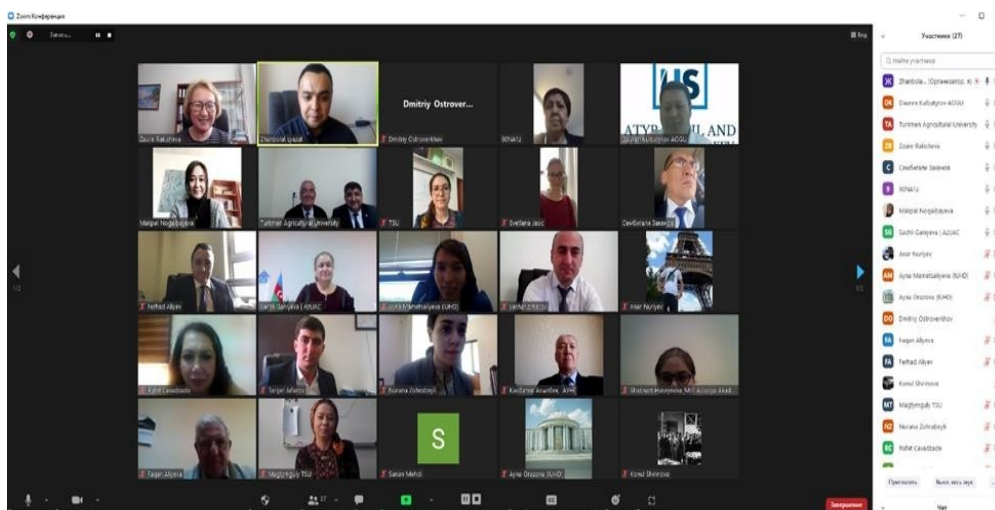

The 8th Meeting of the Board of Directors is attended by a number of leading world universities, such as the University of Tsukuba, the University of Bordeaux, the National University of Taiwan, the University of Sao Paulo, the University of Technology Malaysia, the University of California at Irvine (CiC research Partner), Utrecht University (CiC research Partner), the University of Grenoble-Alpes, the University of Ohio State, Ruhr University Bochum.

An important stage of the participation of the Al-Farabi KazNU delegation was the signing of an agreement on bilateral cooperation with the University of Bordeaux. Also during this visit, agreements were concluded on expanding collaboration with the University of Grenoble-Alpes and the University of Tsukuba.

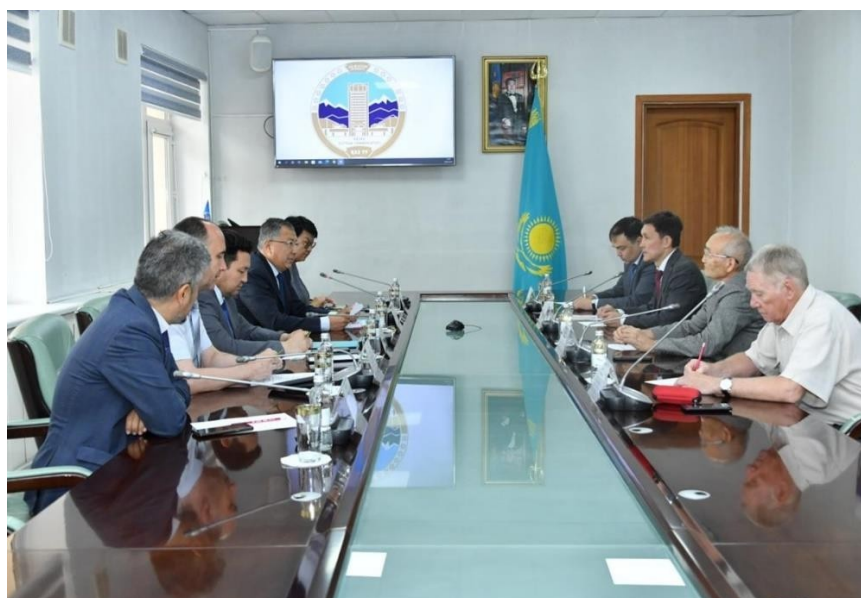

Within the framework of this large-scale event it is planned to hold 5 international meetings. We invite you to take part in this event too," Sayabek Sakhiyev stated.

As a result of the meeting an agreement was reached on the creation of a Consortium between the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University and the Institute of Nuclear Physics within the educational programs for specialized training of students.

It is aimed at transparency, objectivity, verifiability and accessibility of information sources, determining the quality of educational programs in areas and levels of training based on compliance with the "Berlin principles".

Al-Farabi KazNU has made a breakthrough in this ranking by increasing the number of indexed scientific publications in world journals Q1-Q2 and the citation index. This clearly demonstrates the effectiveness and relevance of scientific research carried out by scientists of Al-Farabi KazNU.

Being a classical multidisciplinary university combining education, science and innovation, Al-Farabi KazNU is the leader in the number of scientific projects and publications in the country. Every fifth Kazakhstani publication in rating publications belongs to the university. Five scientific journals are included in the international database. The cumulative h-index of scientists working at Al-Farabi KazNU is more than 3,100 people.

It should be noted that this year Al-Farabi Kazakh National University has risen by 25 positions in the international QS WUR rating and has been placed on 150th position. This important achievement is the result of the well-coordinated work of the management, scientists and students aimed to transform the university into a world-class research university.

AL-FARABI KAZNU WAS AWARDED THE STATUS OF A RESEARCH UNIVERSITY

By the decree of the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Al-Farabi Kazakh National University was awarded the status of a research university.

Today, Al-Farabi Kazakh National University is the only university in Kazakhstan and Central Asia that has entered the top 150 best universities in the world. In one year, the university has moved up 25 positions within the Top 200 of the QS WUR global ranking, rising from 175 positions to 150th place. 25% of the university's educational programs are represented in the Top 500 of the QS by Subject rating.

The university has 16 faculties and 68 departments, 8 research institutes and 29 research centers. There are 140 scientific and educational research laboratories. The total number of students is about 26 thousand. The contingent of foreign students is growing every year - more than 2.5 thousand foreigners from 30 countries of the world are studying in bachelor's, master's and doctoral studies. The number of teaching staff is over 2 thousand. Among the university professors there are 10 academicians and 7 corresponding members of the National Academy of Sciences, 14 laureates of the State Prize in the field of science and technology.

The main vector of the university's development is internationalization. The University has concluded more than 500 international agreements with foreign universities and research centers. In the current academic year more than 100 foreign professors and scientists from 30 countries of the world conducted classes at the university. In addition, over 40 university professors have conducted lectures abroad at universities in Hungary, Germany, Mongolia, France, the USA, Russia, Turkey, Uzbekistan and other countries.

This year 41 teachers and employees of the university have won the scholarship of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Bolashak". The largest number of fellows will be interned at universities in the USA, Europe, as well as at universities in Japan and Turkey.

In May of this year, as part of the state visit of the President of Kazakhstan to Turkey and the Kyrgyz Republic, Al-Farabi KazNU branches were opened in Istanbul and Bishkek. Today the university has a significant potential for solving strategic tasks. Further development of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University is transformation into a world-class research university and promotion into the international educational and scientific space.

AL-FARABI KAZNU HAS A SUMMER SCHOOL FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

Students from all over the world studying Russian, Kazakh languages and other specialties on the basis of the leading university of the country study at Al-Farabi KazNU as part of the academic mobility program in the summer.

Currently, 45 students from the USA are studying under the Flagship program initiated by the American Councils for International Education and the Faculty of International Relations of Al-Farabi KazNU.

And also on the basis of the Faculty of Pre-university Training, 18 students from China, the USA, Yemen and Afghanistan study Kazakh and Russian within the framework of the Bologna Process Center and the Intergovernmental Agreement.

The Flagship program has been implemented since 2015 on the basis of the American Center for American and Democratic Studies at Al-Farabi KazNU. Since then, more than 500 students have been trained offline and online.

Russian is studied by American students under the program "Russian language and International Relations" (full-time), some students study Kazakh (elementary level). The duration of the summer semester is eight weeks.

Circles and clubs work within the framework of the program: "Discussion political club", "History and culture of Kazakhstan", "Traditions and culture of the peoples of Kazakhstan".

The cultural program planned by the American Council includes: visits to the national Museum, nature reserves and other attractions of Almaty and its surroundings.

An important part of the program is immersion in the language environment, culture, establishing contacts with university students, participating in faculty and university events, visiting museums, theaters, participating in sports sections and competitions, creative contests, joint excursions and trips around Kazakhstan with Kazakhstani students.

The Institute of Linguistic Partners should be named as an interesting format for teaching the Russian language and getting to know the daily life of young people in Kazakhstan. Throughout the entire period of study, foreign students are helped to adapt to the country, spend interesting time by their linguistic partners from among Kazakhstani student volunteers.

A COMPETITION FOR EDUCATIONAL GRANTS OF "QAZAQSTAN HALQYNA" HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED

The Public Foundation "Qazaqstan Halqyna" this year announced a competition for awarding grants and scholarships within the framework of the charity program "Educational grants of "Qazaqstan Halqyna ".

The Foundation provides grants with scholarships for applicants from low-income rural families, orphans and children with disabilities who have not received a state or other grant to pay for higher education under bachelor's degree programs.

Applicants for a grant and scholarship from the Public Foundation "Qazaqstan Halqyna" must submit application to the admissions committee of the selected university in the period from August 10-17. It should be noted that the applicant must apply independently. Applicants should consider that the requirements for the Unified National Testing may change, therefore it is necessary to clarify this information from the university he/she is planning to apply.

The Foundation also provides an opportunity for students studying on paid basis to continue their studies at the expense of the Fund. To receive a grant and a scholarship from the Public Foundation "Qazaqstan Halqyna", students should submit online applications from August 1 to August 15 on the website of the NGO "Taiburyl": <https://www.taiburyl.kz/>.

Grantees must comply with the academic requirements of the host university and are required to complete a full course of study during the program. Failure to comply with this condition may be grounds for termination of financial support.

The grant with a scholarship covers the entire period of study under the bachelor's degree programs, from the moment of conclusion of contracts within the framework of the program. The limit on the cost of training is up to 1 million KZT for each student-grantee, if the annual cost of training of a student exceeds the amount indicated above, the difference must be paid by the student-grantee himself.

The grant allocated by the Foundation is gratuitous assistance. The amount is non-refundable and after completing the training, the grant holder is not obliged to work off the funds spent on his training.

The selection of applicants and the final decision are carried out by the admissions office or any other commission operating under the chosen universities within the framework of the implementation of educational grants. Applicants for a grant among students are selected by a commission established at the NGO "Taiburyl". The second task involves the systematic adaptation of educational programs to future conditions.

Thirdly, it is necessary to ensure close cooperation of university scientists with production, the real sector of the economy, large enterprises and to increase the real contribution of the university to the country's economy.

It is also very important to form the digital thinking of teachers, students and staff and switch to the "paper-free university" format. This is reflected in the task of creating an effective corporate governance model to ensure the sustainable development of the university.

AL-FARABI KAZNU JOURNALS IN THE WEB OF SCIENCE DATABASE

The Bulletin series of the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University are included in the "Emerging Sources Citation Index" within the Web of Science Core Collection system. Nowadays the number of scientific journals indexed in the database reaches 7, which is the highest indicator among HEI and Research Institutes in Kazakhstan.

The three scientific journals of the Al-Farabi KazNU, namely, the series of the Bulletin "Chemical", "Physical" and "Mathematics, Mechanics and Informatics" has expanded the list of university publications indexed in the Web of Science. This database already includes journals "International Journal of Mathematics and Physics", "International Journal of Biology and Chemistry", as well as "Eurasian Chemical-Technological Journal" and "News of the National Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Kazakhstan – Series Physico-Mathematical", which was recently joined the list with Al-Farabi KazNU. As it follows from Clarivate Analytics' policy, the journal selection for Emerging Sources Citation Index is the first and important step on the way for the journal to get included in the main Web of Science Core Collection Database, which in turn will give an impact-factor index, based on the citation index. The inclusion of three University journals in the most authoritative international database indexing the best scientific publications in the world is another confirmation of the course of internationalization and the formation of a research university..





TURKISH PROFESSOR ISMAIL BOZTOSUN DELIVERED A LEADERSHIP LECTURE

Ismail Boztosun, Director of the TENMAK – Turkish Energy, Nuclear and Mineral Research Agency under the Ministry of Energy and Natural Resources of the Republic of Turkey, delivered a leadership lecture on "TENMAK Research and Development: from Detectors to Nuclear Medicine" at the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University.

Dr. Boztosun is the founder of the Center for Nuclear Research and Applications in Turkey. He has published over 100 international SCI articles with a 28 H-index of over 2,000 citations. Moreover, he is also a member of the Turkish Physical Society. Dr. Boztosun is the coordinator of accelerator and radiating technologies and a member of the Physics Faculty of Akdeniz University.

"Al-Farabi Kazakh National University is one of the most prestigious educational institutions in Central Asia. Many of our scientists from the Turkic background, served the interests of humanity. And such events are of great importance for the development of education and science. This is a significant event within the framework of strengthening integration ties in the field of nuclear physics and nuclear medicine, increasing cooperation between the two countries and training highly qualified specialists of a new formation. We are always ready to share our experience with the youth who eagers to study. In this regard, the opportunity to study in Turkey under such programs as "Türkiye bursları", "Mevlana", "El-Farabi", etc. is provided for inquisitive youth," - the professor emphasized.

Dr. Ismail Boztosun shared his vision of the role of global science development and familiarized with the work of the TENMAK. Further, the lecturer elaborated on the most significant stages of the development of nuclear medicine and energy in Turkey. Then he gave a detailed overview of research and theoretical developments related to the main achievements of the TENMAK project.





TURKESTAN

Two ultramodern nanosatellites of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University were launched into the upper atmosphere 50 kilometers away from Turkestan. This experimental test took place as part of the opening of the UniSat educational hub in partnership with Kazakhstan-UNICEF.

UniSat is a joint educational program of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University and Kazakhstan-UNICEF. Its goal is to develop the knowledge and skills of girls in the field of nanosatellite development, as well as to improve skills such as teamwork, public speaking, time management and creativity. The program is aimed at eliminating gender stereotypes and unequal representation of girls in STEAM education.

"The UniSat Al-Farabi KazNU satellites are intended for educational purposes and belong to the class of small spacecraft weighing from 1 to 10 kg. They are equipped with several cameras and sensors. The receivers collect data on temperature, pressure, and humidity. They also measure air pollution, determine the concentrations of microparticles PM2.5 and PM10, which are considered very dangerous for the human body," comments project coordinator – General Director of the cluster of Engineering and High Technologies of Al-Farabi KazNU Amirkhan Temirbayev.

Al-Farabi KazNU has two launched nanosatellites of the Al-Farabi series on its account. The second nanosatellite launched in 2018 by Elon Musk's company SpaceX is still operating normally.

By the way, Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, being the Global hub of the UN Academic Impact Program on Sustainable Development, coordinates and actively engages the world academic community in the implementation of 17 goals of sustainable human development aimed at preserving the planet's resources, ensuring access to quality education and well-being, innovation development, ecosystem conservation, etc.





AL-FARABI KAZNU DISCUSSED GLOBAL TRENDS AND THE BEST STRATEGIES FOR EXPORTING EDUCATION

The VI Central Asian International Forum "Transnational Interaction in the global educational space" was held at the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University with the participation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan Sayasat Nurbek.

The largest international forum organized by the INDEPENDENT AGENCY FOR ACCREDITATION AND RATING (IAAR) is aimed at ensuring the quality of education, creating an international dialogue platform for discussing and exchanging best practices in education in the context of digital transformation.

The Forum continued its work in the framework of panel sessions: "The impact of global reality on the development of education", "University Architecture: New Models and opportunities", "Quality of medical education in the era of digital transformation", "Student- centered approach: Management and Culture", etc.





AL-FARABI KAZNU IS THE LEADER IN THE INTERNATIONAL IAAR EURASIAN UNIVERSITY RANKING 2022

According to the results of the international university ranking "IAAR Eurasian University Ranking (EUR)" 2022 conducted by the Independent Agency for Accreditation and Rating (IAAR), Al-Farabi Kazakh National University was recognized as the first and best university among universities in Kazakhstan, Russia, Kyrgyzstan, Belarus, Ukraine, Azerbaijan and Moldova.

The top three included Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation and Osh State University.

The international rating IAAR EUR ranks universities based on four indicators: the quality of education (20%), the scientific potential of the university (30%), the international recognition of the university (20%), the academic reputation of the university (30%). The methodology of the rating IAAR EUR is approved by international experts of the international audit IREG (Observatory on Academic Ranking and Excellence).

The IAAF EUR rating evaluates the competitiveness of universities according to the latest global trends. The high positions of universities in this rating make it possible to attract more foreign applicants, increase the level of internationalization of education and the image attractiveness not only of the universities themselves, but also of the country as a whole. Al-Farabi Kazakh National University once again demonstrated high competitiveness and successful integration into the global scientific and educational space.





MEMORANDUM BETWEEN AL-FARABI KAZNU AND QATAR UNIVERSITY WAS SIGNED

Within the framework of the Kazakh-Qatari Investment Forum in Astana, a Memorandum between Al-Farabi KazNU and Qatar University was signed.

The meeting of the Chairman of the Board – Rector of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Zhanseit Tuimebayev with the President of Qatar University Hassan Rashid Al- Derham ended with the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between the two universities, which determined the directions of further partnership.

The Al-Farabi Kazakh National University hosted a meeting with the director of the Earth Institute at Columbia University, Yanis Ben Amor.

Welcoming the guest, Chairman of the Board – Rector of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Zhanseit Tuimebayev acquainted him with the main areas of cooperation with leading universities of the world and the activities of a research university aimed at improving global competitiveness and training highly qualified specialists in demand.

Currently more than ten agreements have been signed between Al-Farabi KazNU and leading universities, research centers, associations, and non-governmental organizations in the United States and various educational programs and scientific and innovative joint projects are being successfully implemented. The long-term cooperation of the university with the American Council, which dates back to 2014 was noted. Al-Farabi KazNU annually accepts students from different universities in America for one-year and summer internship programs. During this period 340 students from the US were trained by the following programs: “Flagship” and “Russian Language and International Diplomacy”.

Since 2011 a joint program of Al-Farabi KazNU and the Earth Institute of Columbia University has been implemented MDP/Global Classroom, uniting 24 leading universities of the world. Global classroom is online courses that promote interdisciplinary collaboration and allow students and professors from all over the world to participate in collective assignments and practical training. On the basis of this program, courses are launched in English for undergraduates and doctoral students of Al-Farabi KazNU.

During the meeting, it was noted that in order to improve the human capital index, Al-Farabi KazNU promotes fundamental education and various fields of science through the exchange of experience with leading universities of the world. Over the past two years, eight experts from the USA have been invited to Al-Farabi KazNU to give lectures and conduct research within the framework of the program of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On attracting foreign scientists to universities in Kazakhstan".

In turn, the director of the Earth Institute at Columbia University, Yanis Ben Amor spoke about the activities of the institute and expressed readiness to further develop bilateral cooperation. At the end of the event, the parties exchanged views and agreed to expand the collaboration. Also, the leadership of Al-Farabi KazNU invited Janis Ben Amor as a speaker for a leadership lecture for university students.

AL-FARABI KAZAKH NATIONAL UNIVERSITY IS IN THE WUR - 2023 RATING

Al-Farabi Kazakh National University is ranked 1001-1200 in the Times Higher Education (THE) WUR - 2023 world university ranking. Three Kazakhstani universities entered the world ranking, Al-Farabi Kazakh National University is ranked the first place, followed by L. Gumilyov Eurasian National University (1201-1500) and Satbayev University (1501+).

THE WUR for 2023 has analyzed the activities of 1,799 universities from 104 countries. The ranking is the only global performance table that evaluates research universities via evaluating main criteria: teaching quality, research, knowledge transfer and international views.

Thirteen performance indicators are used, providing a balanced comparison and covering the opinions of students, scientists, university leaders, as well as representatives of industry and production. Performance indicators are grouped into five areas: Teaching (learning environment); Research (volume, income and reputation); Citations (research influence); International Views (staff, students and research); and Industrial Income (knowledge transfer).

Al-Farabi KazNU is dynamically advancing in the international scientific space, which contributes to a successful transformation.





AL-FARABI KAZNU WILL CREATE A FUND FOR YOUNG SCIENTISTS

A forum for young scientists and students dedicated to the Day of the Republic of Kazakhstan was held at the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University. The event was attended by: Chairman of the Board - Rector of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Zhanseit Tuimebayev, representatives of the management and teaching staff of the University, doctoral students, undergraduates and students. AL-FARABI KAZNU ENTERED THE BEST GLOBAL UNIVERSITIES RANKING

Al-Farabi Kazakh National University was included in the Best Global Universities ranking, which covers 2000 best universities in the world.

According to the results of calculations by US News, all universities, including Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, were evaluated by 13 indicators, such as: global assessment, global research reputation, regional research reputation, publications, books, conferences, normalized citation impact, total citations, number of publications, percentage of total publications, international cooperation, the number of highly cited articles, the percentage of highly cited articles.

The ninth annual ranking of the world's best universities by US News & World Report was prepared to give a general idea of which universities are compared and what position they occupy. Since the number of students planning to enroll in universities outside their country is growing all the time. Rankings of the world's best universities, which focus specifically on academic research and the reputation of universities in general, can help these applicants accurately compare educational organizations around the world.

This year, the overall rating of Best Global Universities includes 2000 best universities from 95 countries. The first step in compiling this rating was to create a pool of 2011 universities, which was used to rank the 2000 best universities. When calculating the results, the results of the global Clarivate reputation study were taken into account, the minimum threshold of articles published from 2016 to 2020. These two criteria formed the final rating pool of 2000 universities for 2022-2023.





INFORMATION SCIENCE AND APPLIED MATHEMATICS

The VII international scientific conference "Informatics and Applied Mathematics" was held at the Faculty of "Information Technologies" of the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University together with the Institute of Information and computing technologies of the Ministry of education and science of the Republic of Kazakhstan Al-Farabi KazNU, Lublin Technical University (Lublin, Poland), Turan University and Alikhan Bukeikhan University (Semey, Republic of Kazakhstan).

The purpose of the conference is to discuss topical issues in the field of informatics and applied mathematics. The conference provides an opportunity to bring together scientists who use advanced scientific achievements to solve applied problems, exchange international experience, generate new ideas and improve the skills of young scientists. The target audience of the event is scientists, graduate students, doctoral students of the Republic of Kazakhstan, near and far abroad.





AL-FARABI KAZNU HAS IMPROVED ITS POSITION IN THE RATING OF THE WUR BY SUBJECT 2023

The Times Higher Education rating agency published the results of the subject ranking of world universities for 2023. According to the results of the subject rating "Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject 2023" al-Farabi Kazakh National University has improved its position:

- Arts and Humanities (401-500);
- Business and Economics (601-800);
- Computer Science (601-800);
- Social Sciences (801+);
- Engineering (801-1000);
- Physical Sciences (801-1000).

This year, a large number of universities are included in the world ranking - 1,799 from 104 countries and regions. Universities were ranked in 11 subject areas: "Social Sciences", "Business and Economics", "Engineering", "Computer Science", "Physical Sciences", "Clinic and Health", "Arts and Humanities", "Life Sciences", "Education", "Psychology", "Law". The methodology of the global ranking is based on 13 key indicators combined into five groups of indicators and reflecting the key areas of research activities of universities. The rating methodology includes: Education (30%); Research work (30%); Citation (30%); Internationalization (7.5%); Income from scientific research (2.5%).

Al-Farabi KazNU, transforming into a research university, continues to demonstrate dynamic progress in recognized world rankings.





AL-FARABI KAZNU STUDENTS BECAME PRIZE-WINNERS OF INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS

Two students of the Faculty of Oriental Studies of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University became prize-winners of international competitions.

Second-year undergraduate student of the Department of the Far East Dinara Baishygasheva took first place at the I International Academic Olympiad in Korean Studies for students of Central Eurasia, held at Istanbul University (Turkey), and second-year student of the specialty "Oriental Studies" Albina Bolat took third place at the 1st Central Asian Essay Contest in Korean in Tashkent (Uzbekistan).

The Olympiad in Istanbul was organized for the first time this year as part of the V International Conference on Local History in Central Eurasia. It was attended by students selected from the first rounds among universities of Kazakhstan, Russia, Turkey, Uzbekistan and other countries.

Dinara Baychigasheva, a second-year master's student of the Department of the Far East of the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, under the guidance of visiting Professor Lee Beng Jo, presented her project on the topic "Celebrating the 30th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Korea and Kazakhstan – 30 years of the tourism industry" and took the 1st prize. "It is a great honor for me to participate in the international Olympiad, and I have once again improved my knowledge in the field of Korean studies," she expressed her gratitude to the organizers of the Olympiad and the staff of the Faculty of Oriental Studies.

The Central Asian Korean Language Competition was organized by the King Sejong Institute Center for Korean Language and Culture Studies in Uzbekistan. 38 students from 13 universities of Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan competed in the competition. All participants of the competition had an international certificate of knowledge of the Korean language of the fourth level and higher. After a tough selection and a very difficult essay contest, the first two places were awarded to students of Uzbek universities, and the third place was won by Albina Bolat, a student of the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University of Oriental Studies. According to the results of the Olympiad and the competition, all participants and winners were awarded diplomas and cash prizes.





ISSUES OF ENVIRONMENTAL LEGISLATION WERE DISCUSSED

The Al-Farabi Kazakh National University hosted the international scientific and practical conference "Environmental Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan and problems of its application in practice" within the framework of the implementation of the research project of grant funding of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

This conference is devoted to the discussion of the issue of enforcement of environmental legislation and the development of recommendations for improving and law enforcement practice in modern conditions, taking into account international experience. The organizer of the conference is the Department of Customs, Financial and Environmental Law of Al-Farabi KazNU. Legal scientists from CIS countries, teachers, young scientists, students of foreign and national universities, schoolchildren took part in its work.

Opening and welcoming the participants of the conference, Doctor of Law, Professor E.E.Duissenov focused on the norms of the Constitution of the Republic of Kazakhstan in the field of environmental protection and use of natural resources and outlined a number of recommendations for improving the basic Law of the country. Supporting his colleague was also the Doctor of Law, Professor of Tallinn University P.M. Yarvelaid, who stressed that ecology has no borders, and the problems of enforcement of environmental legislation are relevant in Estonia as well. All these issues today require study and exchange of experience. In turn, the Dean of the Faculty of Law of KazNU, Professor D.L. Baideldinov, noted the need for the interrelation of legal science and legal practice.

Presentations were made by: Doctor of Law, G. Sh., Uzakova, Doctor of Law, Professor Sh. Fayziev, Candidate of Law N.N.S. Razhabov of Tashkent State Law University. They presented the draft "Environmental Code" of the Republic of Uzbekistan, legal solutions in the field of digitalization of environmental regulation and addressing climate change issues. Doctor of Law, Associate Professor E. F. Nigmatullina of Kazan Federal University, Doctor of Law, Professor A.P. Anisimov, who in their speeches presented a comparative analysis of the legislation of the CIS countries, which revealed a number of advantages of the "Environmental Code" of the Republic of Kazakhstan and similar problems in law enforcement practice. Representatives of the Belarusian State University, Candidate of Law, Associate Professor of the Department of Environmental and Agrarian Law O.V.Moroz highlighted the issues of environmental legislation.





LEADERSHIP LECTURE BY PROFESSOR ALAN K. OUTRAM OF THE UNIVERSITY OF EXETER (UK)

Published annually since 2009, the QS Asia University Rankings annually highlights the best universities in Asia.

Al-Farabi KazNU participates in the QS Asia University Rankings for the first time along with world-renowned universities such as the National University of Singapore, Peking University, Tokyo University, University of Malaya, Korean University and others.

The Asian Best Universities Ranking 2023 analyzed the performance of 757 universities. The method retains the key indicators of the global ranking, but also takes into account a set of performance indicators carefully selected for the region.

The 11 indicators used to compile the QS Asia University Rankings are as follows: Academic reputation (30%); Employer reputation (20%); Teacher-to-student ratio (10%); International Research Network (10%); Citations per article (10%) and articles by teachers (5%); Staff with doctoral degrees (5%); The share of foreign teachers (2.5%) and the share of foreign students (2.5%); The share of incoming exchange students (2.5%) and the share of outgoing exchange students (2.5%).

All these indicators objectively and fully characterize the activities of the best universities.

Al-Farabi Kazakh National University actively participates in international rankings, demonstrating a gradual, consistent growth. Based on the results of the global ratings of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University and analyzing its achievements, it is actively advancing in international rankings, demonstrating gradual and consistent growth.

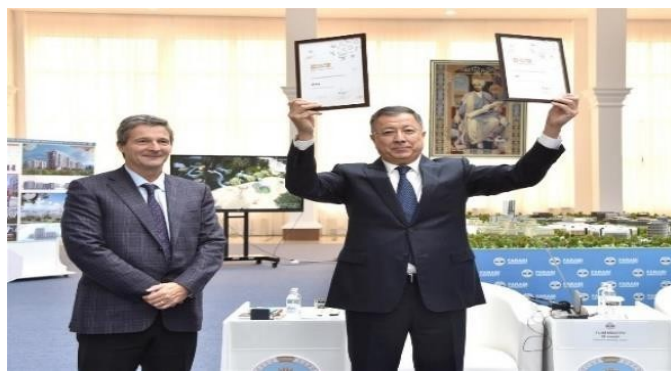

THE PROJECT OF AL-FARABI KAZNU'S YOUNG SCIENTISTS WAS PRESENTED TO THE HEAD OF STATE

Aldiyar Agyshev, an engineer of the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, PhD, spoke at a meeting of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan Kassym-Jomart Tokayev with young scientists in Almaty.

During the meeting the President addressed the youth with a speech focusing on the development of science and higher education in the country. "Science is being formed as a sector that takes the entire economy to a new level. We should not stay away from this global trend," the Head of State stressed. Our country has relied mainly on oil for many years, but now times change. We have entered into new era when human capital is more important than natural resources."

The young scientist of Al-Farabi KazNU presented the project, noting that today scientists in the field of science receive great support from the state.

"Our project is a technology for the development of Nanocomposite Supercapacitors, which includes the production and introduction of domestic batteries. These capacitors, as an alternative to car batteries, will allow the use of mobile phones and other household appliances for new power," he claimed.

According to the researcher, the peculiarity of the domestic product is it will be lighter in weight, thinner and have a longer durability than conventional batteries. The applied features of capacitors are not inferior to foreign analogues, as well as it is much cheaper in the domestic market. This technology is currently protected by a patent of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The issue of launching production is currently being discussed.

"Our main goal is to introduce our project into production and present it to the export of IT industry," said the young scientist of Al-Farabi KazNU.





THE US EXPERT HAS VISITED AL-FARABI KAZNU

Al-Farabi Kazakh National University hosted a meeting with Richard Weitz, an expert on state defense at Wikistrat Crowdsourced Consultancy.

Welcoming the guest, Chairman of the Board – Rector of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Zhanseit Tuimebayev briefly highlighted the activities of the university and promising areas for the development of cooperation with foreign partners.

It should be noted that Richard Weitz is a graduate of Harvard and Oxford Universities. He worked as a senior researcher and director of the Center for Military- Political Analysis at the Hudson Institute.

During the meeting the rector of the university informed that Al-Farabi KazNU has recently been awarded the status of a research university. He mentioned that for the university the issues of expanding ties with the world's leading universities and research institutes are especially relevant.

Today Al-Farabi KazNU cooperates with academic institutions of the USA in various fields and has signed over 13 agreements with leading universities, institutes, research centers, associations, non-governmental organizations of the USA, such as: Michigan Technological University, Northwestern Polytechnical University, University of Wyoming, University of Scranton, etc.

International academic mobility of students and teaching staff is actively developing. Over the past three years, scientific and language internships have been held in American universities: 1 undergraduate student and 33 doctoral students had an opportunity to gain new knowledge. Also, 32 professors of Al-Farabi KazNU traveled to the USA in order to implement scientific projects and to participate in international symposiums. In turn, Richard Weitz thanked the leadership of the Al-Farabi KazNU for the warm welcome and expressed readiness for further cooperation. As a result of the meeting with the representative of the Penn State Law of the University of Pennsylvania, a number of cooperation agreements were reached, opening up great opportunities for the implementation of joint projects in the field of higher education and science.

Associate Dean of the Penn State Law of the University of Pennsylvania (USA) Mr. Stephen Barnes met with Chairman of the Board – Rector of Al-Farabi KazNU Zhanseit Tuimebayev.

The guest of honor highly appreciated the educational level of the university, which trains the best students. Consequently, a number of agreements were reached that open up new prospects for students and scientists of Al-Farabi KazNU.

In particular, in April 2023 Mr. Barnes as an invited foreign scientist will conduct an initial ten-day course “Introduction to U.S. Legal Systems”. In the following years, similar involvement of foreign scientists from among the professors of the Penn State Law (School of International Relations) is planned.

The students with high performance and graduates of Al-Farabi KazNU will be able to study under the scholarship program "Master of Law" at Penn State Law. For this purpose 11 grants have been allocated for training in various programs worth 35, 000 to 54, 000 USD.

In addition, American colleagues provide two places for exchange students for the fall semester of 2023 worth up to 54,000 USD, positions of visiting researchers for professors of Al-Farabi KazNU, as well as the signing of a Memorandum of Cooperation (MOU) for a five-year term.

Penn State University is one of the largest universities in the USA that teaches over 100 thousand students. For many years the institution maintains the status of one of the best American public universities in the top 100 universities, according to QS World University Rankings 2023.

The initial investments of the Penn State Law are estimated at 668,000 USD and are dedicated to students and graduates of Al-Farabi KazNU who have distinguished themselves in the academic community of the University of Pennsylvania.





CONSUL GENERAL OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN MOHSEN FAGANI VISITED THE FACULTY OF ORIENTAL STUDIES

AL-FARABI KAZNU STUDENTS BECOME PRIZE-WINNERS IN WORLD SPORTS COMPETITIONS

Students of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University occupied top places in world sports competitions.

At the recent World Championships in Pontevedra (Spain), 3rd-year student of the Faculty of Medicine and Healthcare of Al-Farabi KazNU Asyl Aitakyn won a bronze medal in freestyle wrestling. The athlete competed in the category up to 61 kg. Last year he took part in the World Championship in Belgrade and became a bronze medalist.

Konstantin Malinovsky, a 2nd-year master's student of the Faculty of Medicine and Healthcare, took part in the Asian Air Rifle Shooting Championship, which took place on November 11 in Daegu (South Korea) and won a bronze medal. In this sports competition, he competed as part of the national team of Kazakhstan with athletes from Kuwait, India, Mongolia, Korea and Bangladesh. As a result, the national team won the silver medal, scoring a total of 11 out of 17 points.

A student of the Faculty of Law of Al-Farabi KazNU Abiba Abuzhakynova won a bronze medal at the Grand Slam judo tournament in Abu Dhabi. In addition, she is the bronze medalist of the 2022 World Championship in Tashkent. Abiba is the first Kazakh girl to become a prize-winner of the World Judo Championship. The talented athlete won the title of national champion in 2021. Abiba is a student of the school of higher sports skills, as well as a silver medalist of the European Cup, two-time silver medalist of the Asian Championship, winner of the Asian Cup.

RESEARCH OF AL-FARABI KAZNU'S SCIENTIST IS CONTINUED IN THE USA

The Research Center of Medicinal Plants of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University has started working together with scientists from the University of Mississippi in the USA.

Recently a small production facility for the development of innovative products based on plant raw materials was opened at the research center with the participation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan Sayasat Nurbek and Chairman of the Board – Rector of Al-Farabi KazNU Zhanseit Tuimebayev.

One of the popular products of the research center is a biologically active additive against influenza viruses and COVID -19. The composition of the natural tincture, developed in 2020 includes plants that improve lung function, blood thinning characteristics, splitting cholesterol in the blood, improving blood circulation and expectorant effects. In addition, the remedy restores energy and can help maintaining healthy sleep.

The director of the Center Zhanar Zhenis has recently visited the University of Mississippi in order to study in depth the active effects of this mixture on COVID-19. As a result of this research, biological products manufactured on the basis of Al-Farabi KazNU will be comprehensively studied in modern laboratories of the University of the USA, and its therapeutic effect in other diseases will be determined.

"Our goal is to isolate the main biologically active compounds in the composition of the prepared mixture, then to improve its structure and study its pharmacological activity. Currently an in-depth study of the mixture against influenza and COVID-19 is being conducted jointly with scientists from the University of Mississippi and our researcher Zhanna Akzhigitova," the author of the project, Professor Zhanar Zhenis claims.

Scientists of the center have been studying the properties of medicinal plants for twenty years. Previously supplements for immune enhancement, against influenza and liver diseases were produced, as well as herbal tea that lowers blood-sugar, regulates blood pressure, improves gastrointestinal system and increases immunity.





THE SHARE OF AL-FARABI KAZNU SCIENTISTS IN ELSEVIER WILL INCREASE

DISCUSSION OF THE PRESIDENT'S INSTRUCTIONS ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF SCIENCE

A meeting of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan was held at the "Gylym Ordasy" under the National Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Kazakhstan, dedicated to discussion the instructions of the Head of State on development of science.

The event was attended by Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan Sayasat Nurbek, Deputy Prime Minister - Minister of Trade and Integration Serik Zhumangarin, Chairman of the Board –Rector of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Zhanseit Tuimebayev, heads of higher educational institutions, academics and scientists, as well as representatives of the scientific community.

The main report of the meeting of the Minister of Science and Higher Education Sayasat Nurbek was devoted to the implementation of the instructions of the Head of State. "The President noted that the creation of a diversified, technological economy is not just a necessity for us, this path has no alternative. Unprecedented challenges of the time such as pandemics, the food and energy crisis, trends in carbon neutrality, transition to industry 4.0. – all these in sum actualize the agenda of innovative development, the directions of which were set by the President" the minister stressed at the beginning of his report.

The Ministry announced three competitions for grant funding for 2023-2025 for the following areas: for the Zhas Galym project with a budget of 3 billion KZT; a competition for young scientists on scientific and (or) scientific and technical projects for 2023-2025 with a budget of 9 billion KZT; as well as a general competition for 2023-2025 with a budget of 74 billion KZT. In general, science funding has increased by 70% in three years. Competitions for grant and targeted funding are held annually. In order to increase the competitiveness of the scientific ecosystem, 1.7 billion KZT has been allocated for the modernization of the material and technical equipment of organizations.

According to the development plan of universities as centers of first-class science, branches of 5 leading foreign research universities are currently open in the country. Indicators of research activity in the country in recent years are higher than in most post- Soviet countries.





AL-FARABI KAZNU IMPLEMENTS JOINT PROJECTS WITH ANKARA AND GAZI UNIVERSITIES

PROFESSOR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF READING GAVE A LECTURE AT HIS ALMA MATER

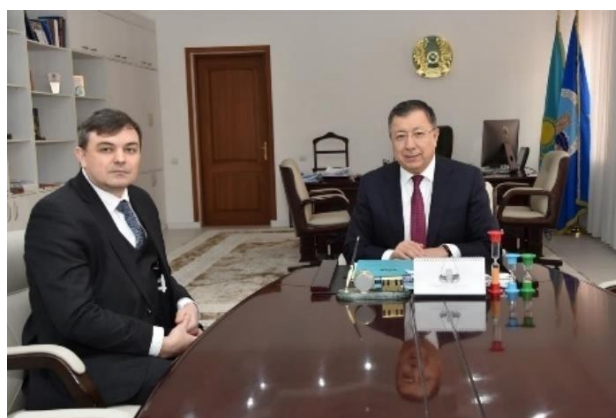
